



Henley-Putnam University Certificate Program

Entrance Requirements

Anyone can take the Entry Level Certificate and all certificates are worth 18 quarter units. The student taking an Entry Level Certificate must pass with a 2.0 GPA in each course.

Only someone who has taken our Entry Level Certificate, or has at least a bachelor's degree may take our Mid Level Certificate and all certificates are worth 18 quarter units. Since the first two of the four courses offered at the Mid Level are a primer for the subject being taught, it is not necessary that the student demonstrate past experience in this field. However, the student taking a Mid Level Certificate must pass with a 3.0 GPA in each course.

Only someone who has taken our Entry Level and Mid Level Certificates or has at least a bachelor's degree may take our Senior Level Certificate and all certificates are worth 18 quarter units. The student taking a Senior Level Certificate must pass with a 3.0 GPA in each course. If the individual has not taken at least our Mid Level Certificate, they must also demonstrate at least one year of related experience in a specific area of relevant study before being allowed to take the Senior Level Certificate (to be determined by Student Services).
